## **CCLA regulations**

In each sighthound breed and sex and class (Int. Coursingclass, Sprinter, Senior) a CCLA can be awarded, if there are minimum 3 dogs at the start

### **If your dog is to compete for the CCLA, please:**

- 1) mark it on the entry form
- 2) send a proof of the qualification from 2 dog shows – the dog must have earned 2 gradings not lower than "very good" in junior (over 15 months), open, intermediate, working or champion class at a national or international ÖKV show (in Austria) or at the national ÖKWZR Cubwinner (in Austria)

## **CACIL regulations**

In the **international class** a CACIL can be awarded, if there are minimum 6 dogs per breed at the start.

If there are at least six dogs of each sex per breed at the start, the CACIL may be awarded separately to dogs and bitches

If there are fewer than six dogs of one sex at the start, all the dogs and bitches compete together for a single CACIL

### **If your dog is to compete for the CACIL, please:**

- 1) mark it on the entry form
- 2) send a proof of the qualification from a CACIB dog show – minimum "very good" in an adult class
